

# TOGO FACTSHEET

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- > In March 1994, the Republic of **Togo** selected Cotecna Inspection S.A. as the sole inspection agency to execute a DI program for imports into Togo.
- > The program includes the implementation of a Customs Assistance Scheme.
- > This two-year contract which began in February 1995 was one of the measures necessary for the implementation of the Structural Adjustment Program.
- > The contract has been renewed by the Government of Togo for a further period of 2 years until 12 February 2003. It will further concentrate on the transfer of price data from Cotecna to the Customs of Togo, control of goods imported by land, and on the reconciliation of duties and taxes assessed by Cotecna.
- > The April 24, 2003 lease-sale contract consists of a supply, installation and management of a scanner for the import verification in Republic of Togo.
- > May 5 2006 – In term on the 5th amendment, the scanner contract was extended to April 30, 2013, and put an end to P.S.I.
- > February 9, 2009: first amendment to the lease-sale contract of April 24, 2003 with extension of the scanner contract.
- > From February 1995 to December 31, 2010, Cotecna received 151'000 Inspection Orders with a total value of €8.79 billion and issued 57'218 Clean Report of Findings (CRF) for a total value of €7.30 billion.
- > From September 2003 to December 31, 2010, Cotecna scanned 87'875 containers at the port of Lomé in Togo.
- > On November 26, 2010 Cotecna signed an Addendum n° 2 to the Lease-Sale contract of the 24th of April 2003 for the implementation of advanced E-tracking Technology in Togo named S.S.E. (Système de Suivi Electronique).
